Mayan Route: Joya de Cerén

Joya de Cerén is located in the department of La Libertad and was accidentally discovered in 1976. It is known as "the Pompeii of Central America" since in 600 AD. He was a victim of the eruption of a volcano.

This is one of the most important archeological sites in Mesoamerica because it demonstrates what life was like for people. It is a World Heritage Site since 1993.

The route consists of three excavation areas where ten separate structures are seen. Bedrooms, kitchen area where vessels were found with food scraps, clay dishes; also wineries and limited farmland with wooden fences. You can also appreciate the structure where religious acts, rites and consultations to the shaman or community leader are supposed to be performed, as well as the house of people who enjoyed authority in the city.
